RE: Safety Data Sheets (SDS)

To Whom It May Concern:

As required in 29 CFR 1910.1200; KIK Custom Products Inc. (KIK) has developed the required Safety Data Sheets (SDS) for the products KIK develops and manufactures that are considered hazardous chemicals under the OSHA Hazard Communication (HAZCOM) standard. Many of the products manufactured by KIK are either not considered a hazardous chemical or those products have been exempted from the HAZCOM requirements as noted below. Therefore, SDS may not exist for some of the KIK products you purchase, distribute and/or sell.

1910.1200(b)(6)(vii) – The OSHA HAZCOM standard does NOT apply to “OTC” drugs which are packaged for sale to consumers in a retail establishment.

1910.1200(b)(6)(viii) – The OSHA HAZCOM standard does NOT apply to “cosmetics” which are packaged for sale to consumers in a retail establishment.

- The definition of “cosmetic” from the Food, Drug and Cosmetic Act means articles intended to be rubbed, poured, sprinkled, or sprayed on, introduced into, or otherwise applied to the human body or any part thereof for cleansing, beautifying, promoting attractiveness, or altering the appearance.

1910.1200(b)(6)(ix) – The OSHA HAZCOM standard does NOT apply to “consumer products” used in the workplace for the purpose intended by the chemical manufacturer...and the use results in a duration and frequency of exposure which is no greater than the range of exposure that could reasonably be experienced by consumers when used for the purpose intended.

1910.1200(b)(5)(v) – Products Labels are not required for a “consumer product” as defined in the Consumer Product Safety Act or products covered by labeling requirements from the FDA, FIFRA (EPA) or TSCA (EPA).

- The definition of “consumer products” is any article, or component part thereof, produced or distributed for sale to a consumer for use in or around a permanent or temporary household or residence, a school, in recreation, or otherwise; or for the personal use, consumption or enjoyment of a consumer in or around a permanent or temporary household or residence, a school, in recreation, or otherwise.
